- Students need to register for a chess.com account if they do not have one already via https://www.chess.com - Registration is free
- Be ready to play at the commencement of the tournament at 9.30 am
- 7 Round Swiss System
- Each player will play 7 games with a time control of 15 minutes for each player
- Length of tournament from 9.30 am till about 1 pm
- No stoppage between each round
- Entry fee of \$20 per player

- Each school competing must send details of an adult supervisor with their team
- Places are strictly limited and will be allocated in order of receipt of booking form and payment
- Closing date for entry is Wednesday September 9th.

Instructions for Chess Victoria online Zonal Tournaments

TO PLAY

- 1. Logon to your chess.com account.
- 2. Find the Chess Victoria tournament:
 - **Secondary Students must do the following immediately: In chess.com, perform the following:

 Connect > Clubs > Find Clubs > "Chess Victoria Secondary" > Click on Join
- 3. Anytime from 1 hour before the start of the tournament the "Join" button will become available:



- 4. Click on "Join".
- 5. Be ready to commence the tournament at 9.30 am. Chess.com will do the pairings for all 7 rounds.
- 6. The tournament will commence exactly on time at 9.30 am in chess.com.
- 7. If you haven't joined by 9.30 am you will miss round 1 but then join and remain logged on and wait for round 2.
- 8. The system will automatically pair you for each round.
- 9. Once the last game has finished for the round, the system will automatically pair the next round and start after 5 seconds!!!
- 10. There are **no breaks** between each round.
- 11. If you finish your round early don't go wandering but **remain logged on and stay on the chess.com screen** and be ready for your next game.
